QUALITY ASSURANCE

Malley Industries has implemented a quality system that is consistent with ISO-9000. The system is generic so as to provide a sound basis for the assurance of quality, irrespective of the type of product or service being provided. Our advanced Quality planning activities ensure that each project being considered is subjected to an extensive review prior to entering into a contract for supply. By following this philosophy, we are able to provide prospective customers with the assurance that we will deliver precisely the product desired. Additionally, the use of an ISO-9000-based quality system permits us to integrate customer or industry-specific quality improvements without re-inventing the system or compromising its integrity.

CERTIFICATIONS

FTQP (Ford Truck Quality Program) & QVM (Qualified Vehicle Modifier) (QVM)-Malley Industries Inc. is certified to the Ford Motor Company Qualified Vehicle Modifier Program for ambulances and its Ford Truck Quality Program for adaptive mobility. QVM certification is restricted to final-stage manufacturers. Malley Industries was the first OEM in Canada to attain FTQP for adaptive mobility conversions on the Ford Econoline platform.

CMVSS Safety Mark - Authorized by Transport Canada: Malley Industries is a licensed motor vehicle dealer and has Ministerial Authorization by Transport Canada as a final stage manufacturer. This authorizes the company to affix a compliance label, containing the National Safety Mark of Canada, to altered and final stage vehicles.

QAP (Quality Assurance Program NMEDA (National Mobility Equipment Dealers' Association) – This program is the only quality program of its type to focus on the adaptive mobility market without being exclusive to a specific OEM platform. It covers three categories: mobility equipment installer, high tech driving aids system installer and structural vehicle modifier. Malley Industries is accredited in all three and was the first company in Canada to be QAP accredited.

Controlled Goods Certification-Malley Industries has been certified in the Controlled Goods Registration Program through Public Works and Government Services Canada, permitting key personnel to examine, possess or transfer controlled goods in accordance with the Defence Production Act and the Controlled Goods Regulations of Canada.

Malley Industries was the first company in Canada to be **certified** by Transfer Flow Inc. (TFI Inc.) **to install modified fuel systems** on Ford E-Series vans.

Malley Industries is **licensed by Health Canada** as a Distributor and Importer of Class I and Class II medical devices.

STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIPS

In 2000, Malley Industries was recognized as an OEM Pool Account with the Ford Motor Company. We are currently in the process of seeking a change in status that would allow Ship Through / Freight re-entry status to complement our existing Drop Ship designation.

In May, 2005, General Motors of Canada recognized Malley Industries as a Tri Party OEM, including Ship Through status.
